Job Responsibilities:

- A. Utilize individual student test scores and teacher recommendations to shape and direct use of the academic curriculum.
- B. Present subject matter to students utilizing STEM Program Curriculum while keeping in mind the camp environment in which the program is set.
- C. Teach rules of conduct and maintain order in classroom settings.
- D. Counsel students when adjustment and academic problems arise.
- E. Discuss students' academic and behavioral attitudes and achievements with parents as needed.
- F. Assume responsibility for the care of program materials, equipment, and facilities.
- G. Assume responsibility for an organized, safe environment for students and staff.
- H. Practice and promote positive interaction with and among students.
- I. Encourage self-direction and self-motivation in students.
- J. Address any concerns to the Program Director and, if appropriate, the Camp Director about students and staff as they pertain to the Camp Blodgett Summer Academy.
- K. Report any maintenance needs to the Director of Operations.
- L. Work with fellow support staff to keep the classroom building organized and clean throughout the week and the season.
- M. Partner with and utilize CBSA Assistants to achieve best student learning opportunities and to help Assistants to develop professionally.
